Blanket measures approximately 26" x 30".

RED HEART® “Baby Econo”®, Art. E257: 12 Ounces No. 1316 Soft White Puff **CA**; 6 Ounces No. 1722 Lt Pink **CB**; 6 Ounces No. 1682 Baby Green **CC**.

Crochet Hooks: 5mm [US H/8].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 14 sts and 10 rows = 4" in pat. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.**

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION: shell = work 5 dc in specified st.

PATTERN:

Ch 15.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across – 14 sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc on next row now and throughout), turn.

Row 2: Dc in next sc and in each rem sc across – 14 dc. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Sk first dc; *dc in next dc, sl st in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 – 7 dc, 6 sl sts and 1 ch. Ch 3, turn.

Row 4 *Dc in next sl st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1 – 14 dc. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 5-10: Repeat rows 3 and 4 three times more. Swatch should measure 4" x 4" / 10.2cm x 10.2cm. If necessary, adjust hook size to obtain correct gauge.

BLANKET:

Beginning at bottom edge; with **CA**, ch 80.

Row 1 (wrong side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across – 79 sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc on next row now and throughout), turn.

Row 2: (right side) Dc in next sc and in each rem sc across – 79 dc. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Sk first dc, dc in next dc; *sl st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; sl st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 – 39 dc and 40 sl sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 4: Dc in next dc; *dc in next sl st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1 – 79 dc. Fasten off **A**. Turn.

Row 5: Join **CB** with sl st in first dc, dc in next dc; *sl st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; sl st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 – 39 dc and 40 sl sts. Fasten off **CB**. Turn.

Row 6: Join **CA** with sl st in first sl st, ch 3 (counts as dc); *dc in next dc, dc in next sl st; repeat from * across – 79 dc. Fasten off **A**. Turn.

Row 7: Join **CC** with sl st in first dc, dc in next dc; *sl st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; sl st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 – 39 dc and 40 sl sts. Fasten off **CB**. Turn.

Rows 8: Join **CA** with sl st in first sl st, ch 3 (counts as dc); *dc in next dc, dc in next sl st; repeat from * across – 79 dc. Ch 1, turn.

Row 9: Repeat Row 3.

Row 10: Dc in next dc; *dc in next sl st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1 – 79 dc. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 11 and 12: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 once. At end of Row 12, fasten off **CA**. Turn.

Rows 13-36: Repeat rows 5-12 three times more.

Row 37: Repeat Row 7.

Row 38: Repeat Row 6.

Row 39: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 40-44: Repeat Rows 8-12.

Rows 45-60: Repeat Rows 37-44 two times more.

Rows 61-66: Repeat Rows 37-42 once.

Row 67: Sc in first dc and in each dc across, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3 – 79 sc. Ch 1, turn. Do not fasten off.

EDGING:

Round 1: Work 3 sc in first sc (corner made), sc in next 77 sc across top, 3 sc in last sc (corner made), sc in left edge of Rows 66-2, working 2 sc around post of each dc on even numbered rows and 1 sc in each sl st or ch on odd numbered rows, 3 sc in edge of row 1 (corner made), sc in free lp of next 77 chs across bottom, 3 sc in free lp of last ch (corner made), sc in right edge of rows 2-66, working 2 sc around turning ch-3 sps of each even numbered row and 1 sc in each sl st on odd numbered rows – 362 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off **CA**.

Rnd 2: Join **CB** with sl st in 2nd sc of 3 sc in any corner, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sc as joining; 3 dc in next sc; *2 dc in next sc and in each sc across to next corner*; 3 dc in each of 3 sc in corner; repeat from * 3 times more, ending final repeat at **; 3 dc in first sc of 3 sc in last corner – 736 dc. Join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 3: Sl st in next dc, ch 1, sc in same dc; *sk next 2 dc, shell in next sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in next dc; repeat from * to next corner; sc in next dc; repeat from * around – 122 shells. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off **CB**.

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg = beginning; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; lp = loop; rem = remaining; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; sp[s] = space[s]; * = rep whatever follows the * as indicated.
